Hike up to our chapel and ring the church bell for all to hear! While you're up there, try your chance at walking on our stilts outside Shooting Creek cabin.

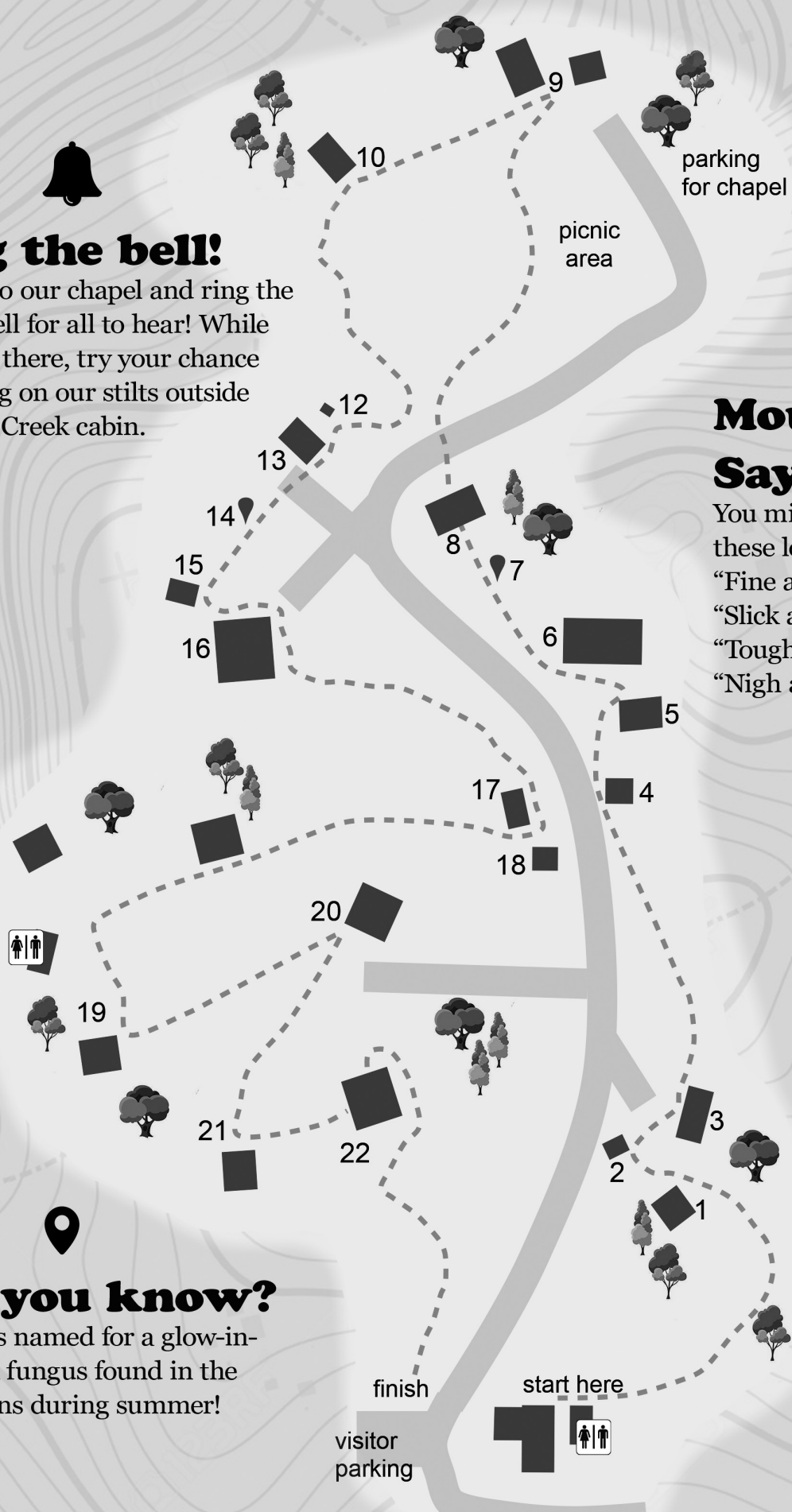
